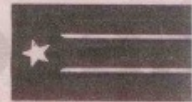

**Re: Public Announcement from the South Sudan Anti-Corruption Commission for the collection of Income Assets and Liabilities Declaration Forms, 2012**

Your attention is drawn from provisions of the Article 120(1)<sup>1</sup> of the Transitional Constitution of the Republic of South Sudan, 2011; section 35 of the South Sudan Anti-Corruption Commission Act, 2009<sup>2</sup>, section 128 of the Penal Code Act, 2008<sup>3</sup> and the Presidential Order NO. 30/2011 for the Declaration of Assets and Prohibition of Private Sector Business in the Republic of South Sudan, 2011 A.D.

In accordance with the above provisions you are hereby informed that the assets declaration forms are ready for collection from the South Sudan Anti-Corruption Commission Head Office in Juba. Please avail a full list of the following categories of employees of your Institutions:

All executive and legislative constitutional office holders, Justices, senior Judges, senior Public Attorneys, senior civil service officials from grade five(5), all the senior officers in SPLA forces from the rank of Colonel upwards and all the senior officers from the rank of Colonel upwards from other organized forces of the Police, Prisons, Fire Brigade, Wildlife and Customs among others at all levels of Government in the Republic of South Sudan as well as persons serving under non-governmental organizations or such other organizations using public resources shall, upon assumption of their offices, make confidential declarations of their assets and liabilities including those of their spouses and children in accordance with the law, and thereafter the declaration of income, assets and liabilities shall be made by the office holder annually at the beginning of the year and submitted to the South Sudan Anti-Corruption Commission by the end of February of each year.

The South Sudan Anti-Corruption Commission takes this opportunity to renew to you the assurances of its highest consideration.
