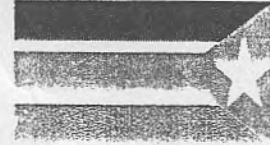

SUBJECT: Frequency allocation for Radio Broadcasting and V-SAT for Catholic Church

We thank God for the joint effort being exerted by our grace, the church and GOSS to serve the people of southern Sudan in different fields.

From the Telecommunications side we are on the roadmap to ease and facilitate this joint effort.

With reference to your letter No ADJ/ABO/299/5/2006 Dated 11/05/06 addressed to the Minister of Telecommunications and Postal Services, we acknowledge the reception of your letter but due to the internal arrangements, within this Ministry, which is still under establishment, and also lack of data of the existing working frequencies of the FM stations are some of the reasons that have caused the delay to reply to your esteem office.

Thank God part of the job is done as such the following FM frequencies have been allocated to the Diocese of the Catholic Church for Radio Broadcasting.

S/No	Diocese	Frequency Allocated
1	Juba	91.000 MHZ
2	Torit	89.000 MHZ
3	Rumbek	89.000 MHZ
4	Yambio	92.000 MHZ

Concerning the VSAT license for the Catholic Church, it will be possible after filling the provisional form which is available with the Deputy Director / Directorate of Telecommunications in the Ministry.

Allocation of the frequencies for the Dioceses of Wau, Malakal and Yei will be made after checking the frequencies currently being used there to avoid duplication
