**Subject: Compensation of Mr. Garang Deng Aguer Dau for Plots
N0.7and 8 DV1-Juba.**

Dear Mr. Governor,

I am writing to your esteemed office in relation to the above mentioned subject, in which, H.E Gen. Salva Kiir Mayardit, President of the Republic, in his response note to the subject matter on a letter by myself to his Excellency the President, dated 3rd January, 2011 commented that, the Petrol Station adjacent to the BoSS, on Plots N0. 7 and 8 DVI- Juba may be dangerous to the bank, and thus, it was imperative for the bank, and for purposes of its safety from any fire outbreak to purchase the two (2) plots from the aforementioned owner in accordance with the law and procedures that pertain to land purchase. A copy of the letter and other relevant correspondences on the subject matter, including the Supreme Court Order which is in favour of the owner of the plots, are attached hereto for the ease of your reference.

However, the former Governor of the BoSS did not implement the directives from H.E the President and as such, the owner of the plots threatens again

to institute legal proceedings against the bank in a court of law, which may not be in public interest.

It is hereby directed once again, that the directives of H.E, the President be implemented by compensating the owner of the plots at the market rate as may be agreed upon by the bank and the plots owner.
